PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION**

1 Upon review of the Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, the Memorandum of
2 Points and Authorities and the Declarations and Exhibits filed by the Plaintiffs in
3 support thereof, and the pleadings and papers on file in this action, it appears to the
4 satisfaction of this Court that there is good cause for granting a preliminary injunction.
5 Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court finds as
6 follows:

7 1. Plaintiffs have moved for entry of a Preliminary Injunction to prevent
8 Defendant Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers from breaching its
9 Registrar Accreditation Agreement with Plaintiffs and from taking actions to
10 implement the proposed Wait List Service; and

11 2. Defendants have responded to Plaintiffs' motion; and

12 3. Plaintiffs have established that it is probable that they will prevail at trial
13 on the merits of their claims for relief against Defendant; and

14 4. There is a likelihood that Plaintiffs will be irreparably injured if this
15 Preliminary Injunction is not granted and Defendant is allowed to continue to breach
16 the Registrar Accreditation Agreement; and

17 5. Plaintiffs have established that the balance of hardships tips sharply in
18 Plaintiffs' favor in that the hardship to Defendant if this Preliminary Injunction is
19 granted is outweighed by the hardship to Plaintiffs if it is not granted; and

20 6. Unless Defendant is enjoined as provided herein, Plaintiffs will have no
21 adequate remedy; and

22 7. The posting of a bond is not required in that Defendant is not at risk of
23 financial loss as a result of the entry of this Preliminary Injunction.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

25 The Defendant, Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers, its
26 agents, servants and employees, all persons acting or purporting to act under its
