As noted in the email sent through Registry Request Service on 10 March 2010 during the ICANN Nairobi meeting, ICANN conducted a preliminary review of puntCAT's request to implement DNS Security Extensions (DNSSEC) in .CAT, in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy and process set forth at <http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html>.

Based on the information provided, ICANN's preliminary review did not identify any significant competition or security and stability issues. As noted in the proposal, implementation requires an amendment to the data escrow section of the puntCAT Registry Agreement. The service is approved pending amendment. We understand that puntCAT will continue to cooperate and consult with the appropriate ICANN staff and experts on details of the full implementation of DNSSEC in .CAT.
