ICANN has conducted a preliminary review of RegistryPro's request to release and allocate single, two and certain three-character names in .PRO, in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy and process set forth at <http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html>.

ICANN's preliminary review did not identify any significant competition or security and stability issues. As noted in the proposal, the proposed modification requires an amendment to the .PRO Registry Agreement (signed 3 May 2002). The amendment will be published for public comment and referred to the ICANN Board for consideration.
