RE: Registry-Level Fee Amendment for DotAsia

Dear Kurt,

We are writing to request an amendment to the Sponsored TLD Registry Operator Agreement between ICANN and DotAsia Organisation, dated December 6, 2006. The requested amendment would revise the structure for Registry-Level Fees paid to ICANN to become identical to the structure recently approved by ICANN for the .mobi and .tel sTLDs.

We have drafted a proposed amendment for your consideration. It is essentially identical in all relevant respects to the mTLD and Telnic amendments, therefore, we trust that it would similarly be approved promptly by ICANN.

For your convenience, we attach also a version highlighting the differences between the Telnic agreement and the proposed amendment for DotAsia.

We look forward to a smooth completion of the matter.
