PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION

Upon review of the Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, the Memorandum of Points and Authorities and the Declarations and Exhibits filed by the Plaintiffs in support thereof, and the pleadings and papers on file in this action, it appears to the satisfaction of this Court that there is good cause for granting a preliminary injunction. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court finds as follows:

- 1. Plaintiffs have moved for entry of a Preliminary Injunction to prevent
  Defendant Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers from breaching its
  Registrar Accreditation Agreement with Plaintiffs and from taking actions to
  implement the proposed Wait List Service; and
  - 2. Defendants have responded to Plaintiffs' motion; and
- 3. Plaintiffs have established that it is probable that they will prevail at trial on the merits of their claims for relief against Defendant; and
- 4. There is a likelihood that Plaintiffs will be irreparably injured if this Preliminary Injunction is not granted and Defendant is allowed to continue to breach the Registrar Accreditation Agreement; and
- 5. Plaintiffs have established that the balance of hardships tips sharply in Plaintiffs' favor in that the hardship to Defendant if this Preliminary Injunction is granted is outweighed by the hardship to Plaintiffs if it is not granted; and
- 6. Unless Defendant is enjoined as provided herein, Plaintiffs will have no adequate remedy; and
- 7. The posting of a bond is not required in that Defendant is not at risk of financial loss as a result of the entry of this Preliminary Injunction.
