Real) 18 I, Kevin Medina, declare: 19 20 I am the principal of RegisterFly.com, Inc. and UnifiedNames, Inc., defendants in the above-referenced action. Unless otherwise stated, I have first hand 21 personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein. 22 23 2. Since early March of 2007, I have endeavored to provide to ICANN all of the data that they have requested. We provided the bulk of the information on or 24 about March 16, 2007, and have been providing updates on at least a weekly basis 25 since that time. The most recent update was provided on May 23, 2007. 26 27 We have had numerous issues with respect to the formatting of the 3 information transmitted to ICANN, and have experienced a great deal of delay and 28

confusion as a result of ineffective communication between myself and ICANN. However, since we have retained counsel in this matter, it appears communication is much improved and we are working on rectifying any remaining issues with formatting of the data transfers.

- 4. The formatting issues raised by ICANN which they claim render RegisterFly not in compliance with the Preliminary Injunction include the following:
- a. Paragraph 5 of the Preliminary Injunction requires that the data transfers be in SFTP format. Initially, RegisterFly's transmissions of data were not in SFTP format. However, they now are.
- b. Paragraph 6 of the Preliminary Injunction requires that RegisterFly perform a MD5 algorithm over each transmission. RegisterFly is unable to do so, since ICANN has not provided a "key" which is necessary to do so. We informed ICANN of this problem in March of 2007, and on March 27, 2007, we received an e-mail instructing us that it was not necessary. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a true and correct copy of that e-mail.
- c. Pursuant to Paragraph 7 of the Preliminary Injunction, RegisterFly has provided the data in a .csv file format, but ICANN claims that this particular file format has caused it problems. We have transferred the same data in the same .csv file format to the ICANN-accredited registrar who purchased RegisterFly's registrations and that entity has had no problems using the data in that format.
- 5. We are working through our new counsel to resolve all of these issues. Setting aside the formatting issues, we have now provided *all* information requested by ICANN and ordered by this Court.
