.org

Canada

Alcohol Policy Network/Ontario Public Health Association (<u>www.apolnet.org</u>)

- We really didn't have a choice. At the time, .CA was only available for national organizations, and we are a project, not an organization.
- The only benefit to .org is you may get more visitors outside of Canada.
- We will retain the rights for .org and keep it for now. Plan to buy rights to .CA to keep that as a future option.

South America

Society of Organizational Learning (Mexico) (www.sol-mexico.org)

- We have a link to the Website of SOL International. It is important we maintain that connection.
- There is no benefit to using a country code. We already have Mexico in the name.
- We are a non-profit organization more importantly, we are an international organization. [benefit of being a .org]

EU Countries

International Federation of Journalists (Belgium) (www.ifj.org)

- We thought it would be better to have .org since it identified us as an international organization.
- .org can be easily explained because it is known. It's just better for us because if we added the country code, we would have to spell out .BE for people because they would not be familiar with it.

Jewish Museum of Belgium (www.mjb-jmb.org)

- When we created the Website in 1996, it was better than having a .COM.
- In the beginning, it was prestigious to have a .org name. It showed you were different than a .COM.
- We will definitely keep the .org and .BE domains. We will add the .MUS domain if that becomes available.

Central Europe

Project Concern International Romania (Romania) (www.pciromania.org)

- We choose to have a .org at the end rather than the country code because we are an international organization, not specific to Romania.
- Our Website is to target people from abroad, mostly the United States, who have Romanian roots or interests.
- We have a sister .org in the U.S., so we try to adopt the same style.

Africa

Afribike (South Africa) (www.afribike.org)

- Our activities extend beyond South Africa so the country code would be limiting.
- .org generally denotes a non-profit organization, which is what we are, and that is why we did that.

Middle East

Israel/Palestine Center for Research and Information (Israel) (www.ipcri.org)

- We are a non-profit organization that works internationally. We work across the borders, particularly in bringing Israel and Palestine together.
- Use of a country code would be harmful it would be divisive.
- .org names are associated with non-profits, and that's what we are.

Asia

Conservative Baptist Association of the Philippines (www.cbphilippines.org)

- It is not necessary to have Philippines twice in the URL. It's already there.
- It is normal for a religious organization such as ours to be .org. It's just understood.

India

Association for Consumers Action on Safety and Health (www.consumersinternational.org)

- Our main headquarters are based in London. We needed to distinguish it from a commercial organization.
- .org indicates it's a not-for-profit organization.
- We will renew the same name because we are part of a federation of world communication organizations.

Japan

United for a Multicultural Japan (www.tabunka.org)

- UMJ is an international organization, and we have more than 60 organizations with 40,000 members in our international network.
- Using our country domain .JP is easy to register with local search engines, but as we are an international organization, we prefer foreign search engines than local.
- We're an NGO, and .org is best to explain that we are an organization.

NON-.org

Canada

Hotel Association of Canada (www.hotels.ca)

- .COM was already taken, and .CA was the next best option. [Why country code was selected]
- Back in 1993-94, .org was not presented as an option. .org just isn't as valuable in Canada.
- *It's clear who we are and where we operate.* [Why country code was selected]

South America

Instituto Nacional de Cancer (Brazil) (www.inca.org.br)

- We really didn't have a choice. We followed the rule in Brazil to include .BR because it was on a Brazilian server it's a rule of the registry. [Why country code was selected]
- At the time (1998) when we included .org in the web name, it was because of the strategy of the Brazilian government to present INCA as a social organization.
- We have kept the current domain name because of the resources we have invested in it.

EU Countries

European Competitive Telecommunications Association (U.K.) (www.ectaportal.com)

- We chose .COM rather than .org because it is not just a site for our association members. It is supposed to be a resource for the entire telco industry.
- We hope to expand e-commerce. The designation .COM is beginning to be interpreted as commerce. So there would be no benefit for us to use .org in our name since .COM is gaining momentum.
- We will keep the same name for the immediate future. We have now spent a lot of money promoting it.

Luxembourg Bankers Association (Luxembourg) (www.abblu.lu)

- *It was easier for us and made more sense we are located in Luxembourg.* [Why country code was selected]
- We are monitoring activities in Luxembourg. It shows that Luxembourg is our focus. [Why country code was selected]

Central Europe

Stefan Batory Foundation (Poland) (www.batory.org.pl)

- It shows we are an established Polish organization. [Why country code was selected]
- .org would have benefits if we want to aggressively go after foreign donors. It would be effective to drop the .PL and just go with .org.

Africa

Johannesburg Chamber of Commerce (South Africa) (www.jcci.co.za)

- We gave some thought to .COM vs. .org. We felt that since we operate in a business-related environment that .COM or in our case .CO was the best option.
- .org suggests an academic environment.

• We will keep the same name because, internationally, we are known by this name in the chamber of commerce network.

Middle East

The Israel Museum (www.imj.org.il)

- When we started in 1994, it was customary to put the country code in. We wanted the national ending.
- It's good for tourism because they are looking for something specific to Israel.
- We actually are considering two changes. First, to add .MUS to the end, and second, to change "imj" to "IsraelMuseum."

Asia

Australian Association of the Deaf (www.aad.org.au)

- Because we are an Australian organization, and .AU is Australia. [Why country code was selected]
- It is more helpful for people trying to get in touch with you to know where you are located.

Japan

Japan Association for Cultural Exchange (www.acejapan.or.jp)

- We thought using .OR.JP would be appropriate because we are providing information of cultural exchange related to the Japanese government foundation.
- We do not think there is any big difference between .org and .IP now adays.
- We would continue using .OR.JP as our main domain because we want to identify organization as a Japanese organization.

Japan Association of Travel Agents (www.jata-net.or.jp)

- When we decided our domain name, we thought that the country code should be the name of the country where our office is located.
- No benefit to using .org. We have spent a lot of money to advertise our domain name.
- The .org domain name has "forward thinking" images, and also "unstable, frivolous nature." We prefer .OR.JP ending.
